Ananda Rangapillai Library, Pondicherry University, Puducherry & INFLIBNET Centre, Ahmedabad organised two day “User Awareness Programme on access to E-Resources” under the UGC INFONET Digital Library Consortium on 25th & 26th September 2008 at the Pondicherry University for Faculty, Research Scholars, Students and Librarians of the University and affiliated Colleges.

The Vice-Chancellor, Prof. J.A.K. Tareen inaugurated the programme and appealed to every research scholar and faculty to develop their intellectual caliber and make research an integral part of their leisure. He opined that UGC INFLIBNET has facilitated research with the spectrum of e-resources to all Universities. Mr. Manojkumar from UGC INFLIBNET gave a snapshot of the advantages of e-resource subscription through consortia to facilitate research and the return of investment for the funding authority namely, UGC. Dr. R. Samyuktha, University Librarian presented the scope of the programme which was followed by presentations made by about fifteen international publishers.
