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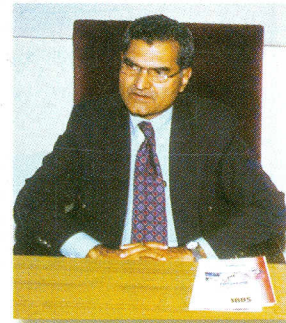
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From Director's Desk



I am happy to inform you all that the prestigious "UGC-Infonet" has been dedicated to the nation by Hon'ble Union Minister for Human Resource Development, Dr. Murli Manohar Joshi on 28th of December 2002 in the presence of Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Atal Behari Vajpayee on the occasion of Golden Jubilee celebrations of the University Grants Commission (UGC). This network will bring the Universities on to the main stream of providing access to latest literature including the scholarly publications subscribed by INFLIBNET for University system. This will bring radical changes in the Higher Education set up in India. We have already started conducting the training courses in collaboration with ERNET on 'Basics of networking, UGC-Infonet and its management'. Several such programmes are planned in the coming days.

Librarians and Teachers will be trained separately at Ahmedabad in coming days on e-access. This training will emphasize on the use of e-resources on the campus to assist the research and academic community within the campus. Centre has made a beginning to conduct the training courses in Hindi which will help the Hindi speaking states to get the benefit of learning the Information Technology applications at ease. Second such programme has been announced in this issue and the librarians can get the benefit by attending the programme. The INFLIBNET Regional Training Programmes (IRTPLA) have been found very useful and we are getting requests from different corners of the country to conduct such courses for the benefit of the library and information science professionals. Many such programmes will be conducted in 2003 also.

We are moving towards organizing the first International Convention "CALIBER-2003". The participation from international delegates is very encouraging and this event will bring more and more countries participating in the convention held in India in future. Hope this convention will help the academicians to discuss the various issues for providing easy access to information.

The new version of the SOUL software is ready for release and three training courses are being organized soon after CALIBER-2003. The success of SOUL software facilitates the libraries to prepare uniform records and in turn help INFLIBNET to develop the union database resulting in an easy access to collections of the libraries.

I profoundly express our gratitude to Dr Arun Nagavekar, Chairman of UGC for reposing faith on the Centre to take up new challenges. I was fortunate to address the august gathering of distinguished Vice Chancellor's meet held at Mumbai during November 2002, under the guidance of Dr Nigavekar. I take this opportunity to extend a warm welcome to Dr. S Ramani the new Chairman of the Governing Board, who played a major role in planning and creation of India's Education and Research Network.

UGC CHAIRMAN VISITS INFLIBNET

Prof. Arun Nigavekar, Chairman of University Grants Commission visited INFLIBNET Centre on 19th October, 2002. Director, INFLIBNET welcomed the Chairman and highlighted the activities of the Centre. The scientists of the centre presented INFLIBNET activities to the chairman. During his speech to the staff members, Prof. Nigavekar said that the role of Information is changing in teaching and research, and hence there is a need for reorganization of certain activities and some of the activities need to be merged.

INFLIBNET is the backbone infrastructure for Information transfer with the development of new initiative viz. UGC-Infonet and E-Subscription to scholarly publications. He also emphasized the importance of content development for e-learning with other expert groups.

NEW CHAIRMAN FOR INFLIBNET GOVERNING BOARD

The well-known R&D specialist in IT, Dr S Ramani is appointed as the new Chairman for INFLIBNET Governing Board. Dr S Ramani has the Master of Technology and Ph.D. degrees from Indian Institute of Technology, Bombay. He worked as a Post-doctoral Research Associate at Carnegie-Mellon University, Pittsburgh, USA, during 1971-73. He served as the first Director of the National Centre for Software Technology, Mumbai during the period 1984-2000, after playing a key role in founding the institution. He has a keen

professional interest in computer and network security, and has done considerable work in this area. Dr Ramani played a major role in planning and creating India's Education and Research Network, now covering a few hundred institutions. He played a pioneering role in Internet technology, directing the team that set up the first Internet connection in India in the eighties, and then built up a large leased line network under ERNET. He has managed the Domain Registration Service in India for over ten years. He has also played a major role in the exploitation of VSAT Technology in India. He played the key technical role in planning and specifying the VSAT network now serving the Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE), encompassing over a thousand VSATs. He was, again, the consultant to BSE in 1999, for planning their WAN based on leased lines, and their big LAN. Earlier, he was consulted for the Baroda Stock Exchange, helping them plan, acquire and commission their trading system.

Dr Ramani has played a major role in education in software technology in India, creating a course leading to the Post-Graduate Diploma in Software Technology and Post-Graduate Diploma in Internet Technology at the NCST, in the eighties. His other roles include: Executive Vice President, International Council for Computer Communication (ICCC) since Jan 97; Member of the Scientific Advisory Committee to the Cabinet in India, during 1997-1999; National Technical Advisor to the Sustainable Network project; President, Computer Society of India, during 96-98; President, South East Asia Regional Computer

Confederation during 97-98; IFIP Trustee during 98-2000; Editor-in-Chief, Journal of Information Technology for Development, IOS Press, the Netherlands, during 1995-2000. He has headed the Programme Strategic Planning Group of ICCC.

Dr Ramani served as Chairman of the Board of Directors, Commonwealth Network of Information Technology for Development, based in Malta, during 1995-2000. He has served on the Board of Directors of ECIL and CMC Ltd., and is currently on the Board of UTI Investor Services Ltd. He has also served as a member of the Steering Committee of the Centre for the Development of Advanced Computing (CDAC), and Executive Committee of the Centre for Railway Information Systems. He has served as a member of the Rangarajan Committee on Bank Computerization and as Chairperson of its Working Group on Technology. He has served as a Consultant to international organizations such as the UN, UNDP and the World Bank. He served as a leading member of the Panel of Experts on Information Technology for Development, appointed by the United Nations. He has designed nationwide WANs for a number of leading banks and stock exchanges in India. He played the leading role as a consultant, during 1997-1999, in planning and creating the technical infrastructure for a major ISP in India, MTNL. Apart from networking, he has extensive experience as a consultant for computerization of banks, educational institutions and companies.

FIRST TRAINING PROGRAMME ON UGC-INFONET

University Grant Commission has launched an ambitious programme to bring about a qualitative change in the academic infrastructure, especially for higher education. Under this initiative, UGC is modernizing the University Campuses with State-of-the-art campus wide networks and setting up its own nationwide communication network named "UGC-Infonet". Trained manpower is one of the most critical resources for successful implementation of high-tech programmes like "UGC-Infonet". Under this programme, INFLIBNET and ERNET India organized the first training programme on "**Basics of Networking, UGC-InfoNet and its management**" during 16 - 21 December, 2002 at ERNET India, New Delhi. Shri Meharban Singh, Senior manager, ERNET India welcomed the participants and delegates. Dr. T A V Murthy, Director, INFLIBNET inaugurated the workshop. Dr. Gulshan Rai, Executive Director, ERNET India spoke on the occasion about the training programme and the facility available at ERNET Lab. Dr. Surender Pal, Director of ERNET India briefed about course contents.

The training session were handled by Dr. T A V Murthy, Director INFLIBNET, Mr. Sandeep Sachdeva, GM-Technical, ERNET Mr. Prashant Shukla, Mr. Vikas Sharma and Mr. Minocha with other ERNET and INFLIBNET representatives.

During concluding function, Dr. Surender Pal, Director ERNET, Shri S K Sharma, INFLIBNET

and Shri Meharban Singh, Senior Manager, ERNET discussed the feedbacks. Training programmes for selected candidates from other universities will be held at ERNET in the first quarter of 2003.

E-SUBSCRIPTION MEETING AT MUMBAI

As a part of the E- Subscription initiative of the UGC/INFLIBNET and as per the priority set up by Prof. Arun Nigavekar, Chairman, UGC, a meeting was called by Dr. T. A. V. Murthy, Director, INFLIBNET to discuss various issues involved in subscribing to electronic journals and databases in the areas of Humanities and Social Sciences for University sector. The meeting was held at Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS) Library, Mumbai on 17th December, 2002. Dr. T A V Murthy, Prof. Ajit Kembhavi (Dean, Visitor Academic Programmes, IUCAA, Pune), Prof. Vidyut Joshi (Director, Centre for Social Studies, Surat), Prof. (Mrs) Mansoor Haider (Aligarh Muslim University), Prof. (Ms) Usha Nayar (Dy. Director, TISS, Mumbai), Dr. Muttayya Koganurmth (Librarian, TISS, Mumbai), Dr. T S Kumbar (Scientist-D, INFLIBNET) and a few others from INFLIBNET and TISS Library were present in the meeting.

Prof. Kembhavi provided a background about the work done with regard to E-subscription activity in the areas of Physical and Biological Sciences and Mathematics and he also

described the models being proposed and issues involved in selecting science literature. A detailed discussion took place with regard to understanding the nature of literature in the areas of humanities and social sciences. Prof. Joshi, Prof. Nayar and Prof. Haider mentioned that the volume of information published in their respective areas is vast and often scattered in different sources and formats. Much of the published literature has yet to become a part of electronic database. They also brought out the fact that there is lot of literature which is not published and is only available in the form of reports, working papers etc. but is useful to the academic community. Experts present at the meeting expressed the opinion that the literature should be selected with due attention to quality and relevance to Indian scholars. While subscribing to E-journals it would be necessary to make sure that the publications will have sufficient longevity and are established in the field. A major concern expressed was that, much of the literature published from India is not presently in electronic form. All the members were happy and enthusiastic about the initiative taken by UGC/ INFLIBNET and they felt that it is timely and useful to the entire community working in the academic sector. At the same time they suggested that existing system of print subscription form should not be disturbed until electronic access becomes well established. During the meeting it was suggested that, different subcommittees be formed to address the issues pertaining to the selection of core resources in Humanities and Social Sciences

disciplines. Wherever necessary, additional experts representing specific subject areas should be associated with the committee. Librarians from different universities and institutions may be consulted to arrive at core list of resources required. Prof. Haider and other members suggested that the network and other infrastructure facilities required for accessing the e-resources not only from the central libraries but also from the departments be provided, together with adequate training. Prof. Joshi suggested that electronic discussion forums and other mechanisms be setup to promote the communication and exchange of ideas among the social scientists. He also suggested that possibilities of involving other bodies like ICSSR , ICHR may be explored to develop information infrastructure. Prof. Kembhavi and Dr. Murthy emphasized that UGC would like to ensure that all the disciplines are covered under this initiative and requested all the members to provide lists of various sub disciplines and sub areas and the experts to be consulted. Both indicated the need to move swiftly and to have core resources in place by the end of March 31, 2003. It was also suggested that the next meeting of the committee be convened some time in the middle of January 2003, by which time a comprehensive list of journals and databases would be prepared and circulated among committee members and other experts.

WORKSHOP ON NETWORK MANAGEMENT FOR LIBRARIES

INFLIBNET organized 5 day "Workshop on

Network Management for Libraries" for developing human resource for network management in academic libraries and institutions during 7 - 11 December, 2002. Prof. S V Raghavan, IIT Madras, chaired and inaugurated the workshop. Dr. T A V Murthy, Director INFLIBNET threw the light on the need of this workshop in the changing scenario. Shri S M Salgar, Scientist-G briefed about the course contents.

The workshop was designed to cover various aspects of network management and security with reference to planning of LAN, secure web hosting and preventive defense (Firewall). This workshop was aimed at imparting specialized training to system administrators, information scientists and others who were entrusted with similar responsibility. The response of the workshop was very encouraging and enthusiastic. 22 participants were trained in this workshop.

During concluding function, Dr. Savita Gandhi, Prof & Head of Department of Rolwala Computer Center, Gujarat University, distributed the certificates to the participants. Shri S K Sharma acted as the coordinator for the programme.

सूचना एवं पुस्तकालय नेटवर्क केन्द्र, द्वारा पहली बार ग्रंथालय कर्मियों (प्रोफेशनल्स) की स्थानीय भाषा में प्रशिक्षण की आवश्यकता को दृष्टिगत रखते हुए ग्रंथालय

स्वचालन के प्रभावी क्रियान्वयन हेतु प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर हिन्दी माध्यम में आयोजित किया। यह ग्रंथालयों में स्वचालन एवं नेटवर्किंग के क्रियान्वयन हेतु आवश्यक सैद्धांतिक एवं प्रायोगिक पक्षों से संबंधित पाँच दिवसीय प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम था। भारत में अपनी तरह की हिन्दी माध्यम में राष्ट्रीय स्तर की स्वचालन एवं नेटवर्क के क्षेत्र में यह पहली कार्यशाला आयोजित की गई। इस कार्यशाला में १६ अभ्यर्थियों ने भाग लिया एवं अत्याधुनिक आवश्यक उपकरणों से सुसज्जित एवं तीव्रगतियुक्त इंटरनेट सुसज्जित कम्प्यूटर कार्यशाला एवं विषय विशेषज्ञ वैज्ञानिक कर्मियों से तकनीकी विषयों को सीखने समझने जानने का अवसर प्राप्त किया। इनको सुबह से शाम तक सैद्धान्तिक पक्ष के साथ-साथ कम्प्यूटर पर प्रयोगात्मक पक्ष का लाभ भी दिया गया। हिन्दी माध्यम से ही विभिन्न पक्षों पर अध्ययन सामग्री उपलब्ध कराई गई।

इसका विधिवत उद्घाटन दिनांक ९ दिसम्बर २००२ अंतरिक्ष उपयोग केन्द्र, अहमदाबाद के पुस्तकालयाध्यक्ष श्री आर.एस. शर्मा के कर कमलो द्वारा सम्पन्न हुआ। अपने उद्घाटन भाषण में श्री शर्मा ने शैक्षणिक एवं अनुसंधान ग्रन्थालयों में स्वचालन एवं नेटवर्क के महत्व के आज की आवश्यकता बताया। कार्यक्रम की अध्यक्षता इन्फ्लिबनेट केन्द्र के निदेशक डॉ. टी.ए.वी. मूर्ति ने की।

LIBRARY PROFILE - KASHMIR UNIVERSITY LIBRARY

Brief History

The history of Kashmir University Library dates back to 1949 with the inception of "University of Jammu and Kashmir". It was established to cater to the academic and research needs of the scholars, students and teachers of Jammu

and Kashmir. With the split of the erstwhile Jammu and Kashmir University in 1969, the collection of the library was shared by the libraries of two Universities viz., University of Jammu and University of Kashmir. In 1975, the Central Library of the University of Kashmir was shifted to its present multistoried concrete building. In 1984, it was renamed as IQBAL LIBRARY and as ALLAMA IQBAL LIBRARY in July 2002. This library (the largest in the state) is presently the Central Library of the University is open from 8:30AM to 7:30PM, six days a week, and has forty-three Seminar Libraries attached with different Departments, Centres, and the Institutes of the University.

INFLIBNET Programme Implementation

As a beneficiary of INFLIBNET Programme of UGC, the library has received funding, training and technical support from INFLIBNET.

Databases of Books and theses are already created in CDS/ISIS and dBase. SOUL Software developed by INFLIBNET is installed at the library during 2001 and database is made available on Web OPAC. As a strong step to support automation in the region, the library conducted INFLIBNET Regional Training Programme for Library Automation (IRTPLA) during July, 2002 for the librarians in Kashmir region, with the financial and technical support of INFLIBNET. It is proposed to conduct more such kind of training programmes and to become a model automated library in the region.

Kashmir University Internet Access Centre (KUIAC)

In June 2002, His Excellency Dr. G. C. Saxena, Hon'ble Governor of J&K, inaugurated Kashmir University Internet Access Centre (KUIAC) in the presence of Dr Farooq Abdullah, (the Ex Chief Minister, J&K.) Dr Omar Abdullah, (the Ex Central Minister for External Affairs.) and Prof Tareen, Vice Chancellor. The library has recently started a number of IT based services for the users. With the establishment of campus LAN and network based Internet service ALLAMA IQBAL LIBRARY is becoming part of Virtual Library System and besides its own and Departmental library collection, it is providing its users online access to various resources available on World Wide Web (WWW). The users can have easy access to catalogues of the collection of other reputed national libraries like Library of Congress, USA, British library, London; National Diet Library Tokyo and other

libraries across the globe. Various National and International news papers are now available to the users on-line for keeping them update. The library is also subscribing one of the leading portal service of India known as J-Gate service where under the contents pages,

abstract and full text articles (wherever available), appearing in more than six thousand reputed scholarly Journals in sciences and social services are made available to the users on-line. Visit www.kashmiruniversity.net/kas1.html

IRTPLA: a new step in INFLIBNET's HRD activities at Regional level.

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Introduction

IT impact on libraries has created requirement of skilled human resources to handle the automation and networking activities. INFLIBNET, since its inception, is laying emphasis on training library professionals to handle library automation activities. In the initial period, more emphasis was given for providing training to the university library staff. INFLIBNET has conducted 20 training courses of one-month duration, 7 workshops of one-week duration and other specialized training programmes in collaboration with NASSDOC/ICSSR, AIR and ERNET. All these training programmes have got very good response from professionals and it is proposed to conduct such training programmes regularly, if possible at regional level also. Apart from these, INFLIBNET organizes CALIBER, a convention for professionals to interact and discuss the issues related to library automation and networking. So far 9 CALIBERs have been held and the 10th in this series, International CALIBER-2003 will be held at Ahmedabad in collaboration with Nirma Education & Research Foundation on February 13-15, 2003.

INFLIBNET Regional Training Programme for Library Automation (IRTPLA)

The libraries at the college level have now started taking initiative in the implementation of automation activities. Based on the recommendations made during CALIBER-2001 at Pune and with the overwhelming requests from all parts of the country, INFLIBNET Centre introduced a new series of regional level training programmes for library and information professionals, called as "INFLIBNET Regional Training Programme for Library Automation (IRTPLA)".

Implementation of IRTPLA

Since the universities covered under INFLIBNET have got the infrastructure to conduct such training courses and also to cover the entire country at different places, it was decided

to utilize these facilities for library professionals in remote places and college librarians. Host institutions were identified at regional level by covering all the states in the country. INFLIBNET provided nominal financial assistance to conduct these programmes and for convenience and more attention, the number of participants is restricted to 20, with a limitation of one participant from one institute. The course is designed with lectures on INFLIBNET activities and services, Basics of computers, communication, networking technologies, UGC-Infonet, Library Automation Scenario in India, Use of Internet in Libraries, Bibliographic Standards with reference to MARC 21 and demonstration and practical on SOUL- the Library management software developed by INFLIBNET. The first IRTPLA was held at Department of Library and Information Science, University of Kerala for the state of Kerala and IRTPLA for other states were held at different places during 2001-2002 as per the following Table (See Annexure).

Conclusion

All the host institutions took efforts and interest to conduct the courses successfully by providing infrastructure facilities and local support. With out the co-operation from coordinators and host institutions, these programmes would have not been so successful. A total of around 700 professionals were trained in these programmes, spread all over the country and 75% of them were drawn from college libraries. There is a strong demand on INFLIBNET to hold such regional training programmes in future at various places in the country.

पटना विश्वविद्यालय स्थित केन्द्रीय पुस्तकालय को आधुनिकीकरण करने के प्रयास शुरू हो गये हैं। इसके प्रथम चरण में पुस्तकालय कर्मियों को सूचना एवं प्रौद्योगिकी तकनीक की जानकारी दी गयी। विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग दसवीं योजना में केन्द्रीय पुस्तकालय को कंप्यूटर एवं सूचना तकनीक के आधुनिकतम यंत्रों से युक्त

करेगा। योजना के साकार होने के साथ ही विश्वविद्यालय के शिक्षक, छात्र और शोधकर्ताओं को विश्व के किसी भी पुस्तकालय में उपलब्ध पुस्तकों, जर्नल और शोध-पत्रों की जानकारियां बैठे-बैठे मिल जायेगी।

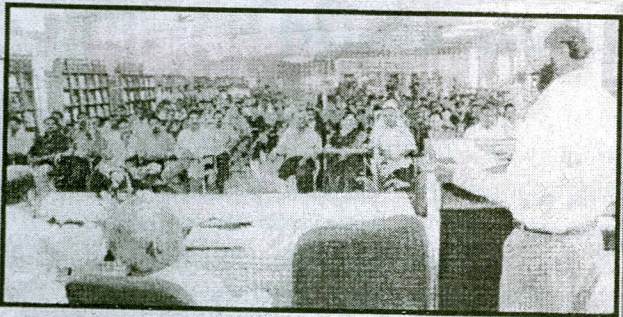
प्राप्त जानकारी के अनुसार, केन्द्र सरकार ने देश के सभी विश्वविद्यालयों के पुस्तकालयों का आधुनिकीकरण करने को अनुशंसा की है। विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग द्वारा दसवीं योजना में पुस्तकालयों सूचना एवं प्रौद्योगिकी संसाधन से युक्त करने के लिए करीब तीन अरब रुपये खर्च किये जायेंगे। इससे पूर्व भी कंप्यूटर आदि खरीदने के लिए पुस्तकालयों को आयोग से अनुदान मिले थे। लेकिन कुशल कर्मियों के अभाव में उद्देश्य में आशानुरूप सफलता नहीं मिली।

आयोग ने पूर्व की असफलता से सीख लेते हुए आधुनिकीकरण करने से पूर्व पुस्तकालय कर्मियों को सूचना एवं प्रौद्योगिकी का प्रशिक्षण देने की योजना बनायी है। पुस्तकालय कर्मियों को प्रशिक्षित करने के लिए इंफ्लिबनेट एंड लाइब्रेरी नेटवर्क (इन्फ्लिबनेट) को जिम्मेदारी दी गयी है। हाल ही में पटना विश्वविद्यालय के केन्द्रीय पुस्तकालय में बिहार एवं झारखंड राज्य स्थित विश्वविद्यालयों के 28 पुस्तकालय कर्मियों को सूचना एवं प्रौद्योगिकी विषय का प्रशिक्षण दिया गया। इस मौके पर पुस्तकालय एवं सूचना पाठ्यक्रम के आधुनिकीकरण से सृजन होने वाले अवसर की विस्तृत चर्चा की गयी। सूत्रों के अनुसार, नौवीं योजना तक देश के उन्नीस पुस्तकालयों को आधुनिक बनाया जा चुका है। दसवीं योजना में पटना

विश्वविद्यालय के केन्द्रीय पुस्तकालय को आधुनिकीकरण करने की योजना बनाई गयी है। ऐसा होने पर विश्वविद्यालय के अधीन सभी पुस्तकालय केन्द्रीय पुस्तकालय से जुड़ जायेंगे। केन्द्रीय पुस्तकालय के निदेशक डा. यू. एम. टाकुर ने बताया कि योजना के पूरा होने के साथ ही विश्वविद्यालय शिक्षकों, छात्रों और शोधकर्ताओं को किताबों की जानकारी प्राप्त करने में आसानी हो जायेगी। इंटरनेट के जरिये केन्द्रीय पुस्तकालय विश्व के अन्य पुस्तकालयों से जुड़ जायेगा। पुस्तकालय के आधुनिकीकरण के साथ ही एक बटन दबाने के साथ ही विश्व के किसी भी पुस्तकालय में उपलब्ध किताबों की जानकारी मिल जायेगी और आवश्यक पाठ्यक्रम का प्रिंट अपनी सीट पर बैठे-बैठे निकाला जा सकता है।

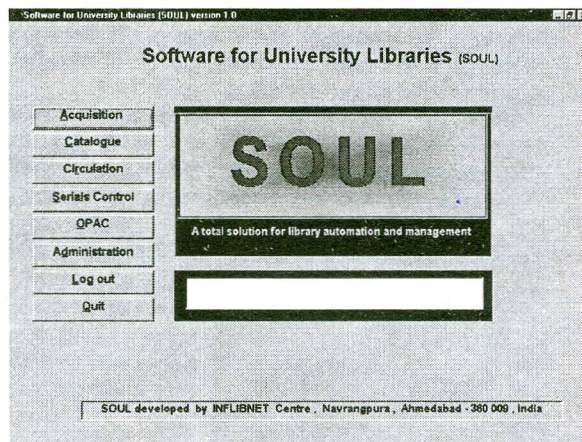

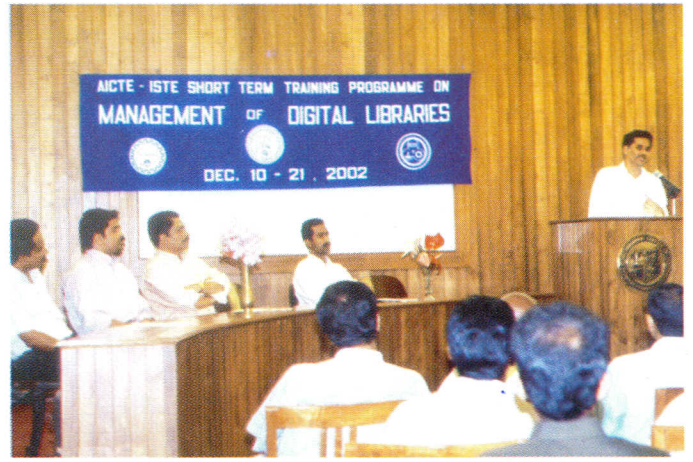
