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# निदेशक की कलम से

## From Director's Desk

### ( प्रिय पाठको )

मुझे आपके सामने वर्ष 2022 के लिए इनफिलबनेट न्यूजलेटर की दूसरा तिमाही का अंक को प्रस्तुत करते हुए खुशी हो रही है। मुझे आपको यह सूचित करते हुए बहुत खुशी हो रही है कि "शोध-चक्र", विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग (यूजीसी), नई दिल्ली के मार्गदर्शन में लिया गया इनफिलबनेट केंद्र की एक अनूठी पहल है, जो की अकादमिक समुदाय को उनके शोध जीवन चक्र के दौरान मदद और समर्थन करेगा, उसको यूजीसी के अध्यक्ष प्रो एम जगदीश कुमार द्वारा 10 मई 2022 को लॉन्च किया गया। और रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि तक, देश में कुल 14 विश्वविद्यालयों ने इनफिलबनेट केंद्र के साथ शोध-चक्र का उपयोग करने के लिए समझौता ज्ञापन पर हस्ताक्षर कर चुके हैं। रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि के दौरान, केंद्र ने अपने द्वि-वार्षिक कार्यक्रम "शिक्षा और अनुसंधान संस्थानों में पुस्तकालयों पर स्वचालन पर सम्मेलन (13वां अंतर्राष्ट्रीय कैलिबर – 2022) की घोषणा की जिसे संयुक्त रूप से इनफिलबनेट केंद्र, गांधीनगर और बनारस हिंदू विश्वविद्यालय (BHU), वाराणसी, उत्तर प्रदेश द्वारा 17 से 19 नवंबर 2022 तक वाराणसी में आयोजित किया जा रहा है। सम्मेलन का मुख्य विषय "नेक्स्टजेन अकादमिक परिदृश्य के लिए पुस्तकालयों में डिजिटल परिवर्तन की कल्पना करना" है, जिसमें राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति (एनईपी 2020), उभरती प्रौद्योगिकियों और पुस्तकालयों में रुझान, मुक्त विज्ञान और मुक्त पुस्तकालय के लिए पुस्तकालयों के इनसेप्टिव दृष्टिकोण पर ध्यान केंद्रित किया गया है।

इस अवधि के दौरान, इनफिलबनेट केंद्र ने 03 संस्थानों के लिए अपनी निः शुल्क ILMS सेवा की तैनाती की जिसमें हिमाचल प्रदेश केंद्रीय विश्वविद्यालय, धर्मशाला; केंद्रीय संस्कृत विश्वविद्यालय, दिल्ली और मानव रचना विश्वविद्यालय, फरीदाबाद शामिल है। केंद्र ने रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि तक संस्थानों के लिए कुल 537 IRINS के उदाहरण बनाए हैं, जिसमें रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि के दौरान 62 उदाहरण शामिल हैं। 30 जून 2022 तक, कुल 704 संस्थानों (654 विश्वविद्यालयों + 50 सीएफटीआई) ने इनफिलबनेट केंद्र के साथ शोधगंगा पर समझौता ज्ञापन पर हस्ताक्षर किए हैं, जहां रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि के दौरान 19 समझौता (14 विश्वविद्यालयों + 05 सीएफटीआई) ज्ञापन जोड़े गए थे। और, शोधगंगा भंडार में जमा किए गए शोध प्रबंधों की कुल संख्या रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि के अंत तक बढ़कर 3,68,271 हो गई है, जिसमें रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि के दौरान अपलोड किए गए 18,271 शोध-प्रबंध शामिल हैं। इसमें कुल 556 विश्वविद्यालय योगदान दे रहे हैं।



### Dear Readers

I'm glad to present before you the second quarter issue of the INFLIBNET Newsletter for the year 2022. I'm very happy to inform you that "Shodh-Chakra", a unique initiative of the INFLIBNET Centre under the guidance of the University Grants Commission (UGC), New Delhi to help & support the academic community during their research life cycle, was launched by the Chairman of UGC, Prof M Jagadesh Kumar on 10<sup>th</sup> May 2022. And till the reported period, a total of 14 Universities in the country have signed MoUs with the INFLIBNET Centre to use Shodh-Chakra. During the reported period, the Centre announced its bi-annual event "Convention on Automation on Libraries in Education and Research Institutions (the 13<sup>th</sup> International CALIBER – 2022) jointly being organized by the INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar and Banaras Hindu University (BHU), Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh to be held from 17<sup>th</sup> - 19<sup>th</sup> November 2022 at Varanasi. The main theme of the convention is "Envisioning Digital Transformation in Libraries for NextGen Academic Landscape" with a focus on the Inceptive Approach of Libraries for National Education Policy (NEP 2020), Emerging Technologies and Trends in Libraries, Open Science and Open Library.

During this period, the INFLIBNET Centre deployed its free ILMS service for 03 institutions in the country including Central University of Himachal Pradesh, Dharamshala; Central Sanskrit University, Delhi; and Manav Rachna University, Faridabad. The INFLIBNET Centre has created a total number of 537 IRINS instances for institutions till the reported period including 62 IRINS instances that were created during the reported period. As on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2022, a total of 704 (654 Universities + 50 CFTIs/INIs) have signed MoU on Shodhganga with the INFLIBNET Centre where 19 MoUs (14 Univ+05 CFTIs/INIs) were added during the reported period. And, the total number of theses deposited into the Shodhganga repository has grown up to 3,68,271 by the end of the reported period including 18,271 Theses that were uploaded during the reported period. A total of 556 Universities are contributing to it.

इनफिलबनेट केंद्र देश भर के विभिन्न संस्थानों के प्रतिभागियों के बीच प्रशिक्षण प्रदान करने के लिए नियमित रूप से ऑफलाइन/ऑनलाइन विशिष्ट प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम और कार्यशालाएं आयोजित करता है। रिपोर्ट की गई तिमाही के दौरान, केंद्र ने SOUL सॉफ्टवेयर उपयोगकर्ताओं के लिए क्रमशः 4 से 8 अप्रैल 2022, 23 से 27 मई 2022 और 6 से 10 जून 2022 तक "SOUL 3.0: इंस्टॉलेशन और संचालन" पर तीन प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम आयोजित किए। इसके अलावा, केंद्र ने दो अन्य विशिष्ट तीन दिवसीय राष्ट्रीय कार्यशालाओं क्रमशः 11 से 13 अप्रैल 2022 तक "अनुसंधान सूचना प्रबंधन प्रणाली (RIMS)", और 11 से 13 मई 2022 तक "जामोवी का उपयोग करते हुए सांख्यिकीय और खोजपूर्ण डेटा विश्लेषण" आयोजित किए। सीएफटीआई/आईएनआई के विश्वविद्यालय समन्वयकों/पुस्तकालय पेशेवरों के लिए शोधगंगा पर एक दिवसीय विशेष ऑनलाइन जागरूकता कार्यक्रम 13 मई 2022 को आयोजित किया गया। केंद्र ने इस अवधि के दौरान N&LIST और InfiStat विषयों पर विश्वविद्यालयों और कॉलेजों के लिए तीन अल्पकालिक ऑनलाइन वेबिनार भी आयोजित किए और इन वेबिनार में कुल 1061 प्रतिभागियों ने भाग लिया। रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि के दौरान, सामाजिक न्याय और अधिकारिता मंत्रालय, राष्ट्रीय सामाजिक रक्षा संस्थान (एनआईएसडी) के ट्रांसजेंडर और भिखारी डिजीवन के अनुरोध पर केंद्र ने जिलाधिकारियों/कलेक्टरों और संबंधित अधिकारियों के लिए 'ट्रांसजेंडर व्यक्तियों के लिए राष्ट्रीय पोर्टल' पर छह ऑनलाइन प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम आयोजित किए।

रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि के दौरान, इनफिलबनेट केंद्र ने अपने सभी स्टाफ सदस्यों के लिए केंद्र में 11 मई 2022 को पूरे देश में योग महोत्सव के उत्सव के साथ अंतर्राष्ट्रीय योग दिवस समारोह के लिए एक अभिविन्यास कार्यक्रम आयोजित किया। इसी क्रम में केंद्र के स्टाफ सदस्यों के लिए तीन योग विशेषज्ञों द्वारा परिसर में 17 मई से 8 जून 2022 तक प्रत्येक दिन एक घंटे की अवधि के तीन सप्ताह के योग सत्र आयोजित किए गए। 17 जून 2022 को सभी स्टाफ सदस्यों के बीच योग विषय पर एक ऑनलाइन प्रश्नोत्तरी प्रतियोगिता भी आयोजित की गई थी। और, 21 जून 2022 को "8वां अंतर्राष्ट्रीय योग दिवस: मानवता के लिए योग" केंद्र में अत्यंत उत्साह के साथ मनाया गया।

इस अंक के अंत में CALIBER-2022 का विवरणिका दिया गया है। मुझे यकीन है कि पाठकों को इनफिलबनेट न्यूज़लेटर के इस दूसरा अंक को पढ़ने में अच्छा लगेगा, जिसमें रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि के दौरान इसकी नई परियोजनाओं और गतिविधियों आदि पर अपडेट शामिल हैं।

The INFLIBNET Centre regularly conducts Offline/Online Specialized Training Programmes & Workshops to impart training among participants from different institutions across the country. The Centre also conducted three short-term Online Webinars for Universities and colleges on the topics N-LIST and InfiStat during the period and a total of 1061 participants attended these webinars. During the reported period, the Centre on the request from the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, the Transgender & Beggary Division of the National Institute of Social Defence (NISD), conducted Six Online Training Programmes on 'National Portal for Transgender Persons' for the District Magistrates/Collectors and concerned officials.

During the reported period, the INFLIBNET Centre conducted an orientation programme for International Yoga Day celebrations aligned with the celebration of Yoga Mahotsav all over the country on 11<sup>th</sup> May 2022 at the Centre for all its staff members. In continuation with that, three weeks Yoga sessions of one-hour duration each day, from 17<sup>th</sup> May to 8<sup>th</sup> June 2022, were held for the staff members of the Centre on the premise by three Yoga experts. An Online Quiz competition was also conducted on the topic of Yoga among all the staff members on 17<sup>th</sup> June 2022. And, the "8<sup>th</sup> International YOGA Day: Yoga for Humanity" on 21<sup>st</sup> June 2022 was celebrated with utmost enthusiasm at the Centre.

Three-day National Workshop on Statistical and Exploratory Data Analysis using Jamovi was organized from 11<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> May 2022 at the INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar. Prof J P Singh Joorel, Director, INFLIBNET Centre inaugurated the workshop and addressed the gathering. ## One Day Specialized Online Awareness Programme on Shodhganga for University Coordinators/Library Professionals from CFTIs/INIs on 13<sup>th</sup> May 2022

One day specialized online awareness programme on Shodhganga for University Coordinators/Library professionals from CFTIs/INI was organized on 13<sup>th</sup> May 2022. Mrs Deepthi Pandey, Project Officer (LS) initiated the programme by giving an overview of the same at the beginning. Prof J P Singh Joorel, Director, INFLIBNET Centre, inaugurated the programme in the august presence of Library Professionals from various CFTIs and INIs from India. In his inaugural address, he highlighted the open access to the Theses available on the Shodhganga portal for wider acceptability instead of keeping it unutilized as all of the theses are laying in the library. He informed that the INFLIBNET Centre has observed that the Institutions are claiming the number of PhD graduating students for NIRF ranking which is much higher than the full-text theses available on Shodhganga. Keeping view of this fact, the

Ministry of Education (MoE), GoI and University Grants Commission (UGC), New Delhi have issued the notification to all the INIs/CFTIs and Universities for uploading the full-text Theses in Shodhganga which are linked with NIRF ranking.

Mr Manoj Kumar K, Scientist-E (CS), INFLIBNET Centre and In-Charge Scientist of the project coordinated the programme and gave a welcome address along with a brief overview of Shodhganga, its status usage, and policy. He talked about the creation of metadata and asked University coordinators to upload the correct metadata. He also answered queries raised by IIMs and IITs during the session related to OAI-PMH, Metadata harvesting, copyright, and the patent issue of the Theses.

Dr Surbhi, Scientist-C (LS), INFLIBNET Centre anchored the programme and demonstrated the overview and workflow of Shodhganga and

discussed the procedure of signing of MoU and joining Shodhganga, and also highlighted the roles and responsibilities of the University Coordinators (UCs) in Shodhganga. She also gave the brief technical details and workflow of the Theses submission to this portal and showed the live demo of splitting, Metadata creation, and the uploading of the Theses.

Mr Rajan Kumar, Scientist-B (LS), INFLIBNET Centre talked about the Shodhgangotri which is an open-access Repository of Research in

progress/synopses MRPs/PDFs/Emeritus fellowship reports. He also shows the new interface of the Shodhgangotri portal which was recently revamped and upgraded to a higher version. In the end, Mr Rajan Kumar proposed the vote of thanks to the guests and participants.

A total of 198 participants registered for the online awareness programme. However, a total of 123 participants attended the same out of which 109 participants were from Institutes of National Importance and CFTIs.

# Current Status of INFLIBNET Projects

## INFLIBNET Learning Management Service (ILMS)

INFLIBNET Learning Management Service (ILMS) is a service offered by the Information and Library Network Centre to institutions of higher education across the country. This service is being offered to all the Central, State and Deemed universities. Some of the core features are Course creation, Enrolment, Assignment & Assessment, Discussion Forum, etc. During this reported period, the INFLIBNET Centre deployed its free ILMS service for 03 institutions in the country including Central University of Himachal Pradesh, Dharamshala; Central Sanskrit University, Delhi; and Manav Rachna University, Faridabad.

## Indian Research Information Network System (IRINS)

IRINS is a web-based Research Information Management (RIM) service provided to higher education institutions in India by the INFLIBNET Centre. IRINS facilitates the academic, R&D organizations and faculty members, and scientists to collect, curate and showcase scholarly communication activities and provide an opportunity to create a scholarly network. The INFLIBNET Centre has created a total number of


537 IRINS instances for institutions till the reported period including 62 IRINS instances that were created during the period under report. IRINS has connected a total of 829,78 faculty members through this project. The project retrieved a total of 14,30,687 publications metadata from various sources and received a total of 154,76,746 citations & received a total of 44,30,741 Altmetrics mentions till the reported period.

## Shodhganga: a reservoir of Indian Theses

Shodhganga: a reservoir of Indian Theses, the repository of full-text theses in Indian Universities has grown progressively during the period under report. As on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2022, a total of 704 (654 Universities + 50 CFTIs/INIs) have signed MoU on Shodhganga with the INFLIBNET Centre where 19 MoUs (14 Univ+05 CFTIs/INIs) were added during the reported period. And, the total number of theses deposited into the Shodhganga repository has grown up to 3,68,271 by the end of the reported period by the contribution of 556 contributing Universities.

The total number of theses uploaded in the Quarter-Q2 (April-June 2022) was 18,271 Theses which is higher than the last quarter Quarter-Q1

(January-March 2022) in which a total of 16,667 Theses were uploaded into the repository.



**Figure 1: Theses uploaded into Shodhganga during April – June 2022**


## Shodhgangotri

In Shodhgangotri, a total of 8970 Synopses/MRPs/PDFs/Fellowships have been submitted to the repository by the end of the reported period.

During the reported period, the Shodhgangotri team developed a new interface for Shodhgangotri. Also, all the Shodhgangotri data were restored to the new VM server. Now, the upgraded version of the Shodhgangotri portal gives greater visibility and accessibility.


## ShodhShuddhi and Plagiarism Detection Software (PDS)

The Ministry of Education through its initiative ShodhShuddhi provides access to Plagiarism Detection Software (PDS) to all universities including Central, State, Deemed, and Private Universities, as well as Centrally funded Technical Institutions (CFTIs) in India through Central funding to enhance academic integrity in academic institutions and to curb plagiarism, w.e.f. 01 September 2019. This program was launched by the Hon'ble Minister of Education during the CABE meeting in Vigyan Bhavan, New Delhi and it is being executed by INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar. As on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2022, a total of 22,72,069 documents have been submitted for checking Plagiarism by 1,30,506 users from 851 Universities/institutions. The rest of the Universities/institutions are either using any other software or research programmes that have not yet started there.




## PDS (OUR ORIGINAL) Usage Statistics

After the lockdown relaxation, submission into PDS has increased as researchers and students are gradually coming back to research and academic activities. Figure 2 shows the average number of submissions in the last 3 months (April-May-June 2022), and the average was 92338. Figure 3 shows the number of users added to ShodhShuddhi from April-June 2022.

The graph (Figure-3) shows the total number of users created/added in ShodhShuddhi to date is 1,30,506 users whereas the number of users added monthly (April – May - June 2022 = 2677) are as follows (April = 832, May = 1058, and June = 787). PDS has a provision for 3 Lakhs users from all Universities.

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
