मुझे आपके सामने वर्ष 2023 के इनफिलबनेट न्यूज़लेटर का दूसरा तिमाही अंक प्रस्तुत करते हुए खुशी हो रही है। इस अवधि के दौरान, इनफिलबनेट केंद्र ने NIRF के तहत भारत रैंकिंग 2023 के 8वें अभ्यास को सफलतापूर्वक निष्पादित किया, जिसे 5 जून 2023 को नई दिल्ली में माननीय शिक्षा और विदेश राज्य मंत्री डॉ. राजकुमार रंजन सिंह द्वारा जारी किया गया। श्री के संजय मूर्ति, सचिव (उच्च शिक्षा); प्रोफेसर एम. जगदीश कुमार, अध्यक्ष, यूजीसी; प्रोफेसर अनिल सहस्रबुद्धे, अध्यक्ष, एनबीए और डॉ. अनिल कुमार नासा, सदस्य सचिव, एनबीए भी इस अवसर पर उपस्थित थे। वहां इनफिलबनेट सेंटर द्वारा किए गए कार्यों की काफी सराहना की गई।

शोध जीवन चक्र के दौरान शैक्षणिक समुदाय की मदद और समर्थन करने के लिए केंद्र की अनूठी पहल शोध-चक्र को देश भर के विश्वविद्यालयों से जबरदस्त प्रतिक्रिया मिल रही है, और रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि तक, देश में कुल 95 विश्वविद्यालयों ने इनफिलबनेट केंद्र के साथ शोध-चक्र का उपयोग करने के लिए समझौता ज्ञापन पर हस्ताक्षर कर चुके हैं जिस में रिपोर्ट अवधि के दौरान 13 विश्वविद्यालयों सामिल हैं।

रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि के दौरान, जहां तक आईएसबीएन पोर्टल के माध्यम से आईएसबीएन के आवंटन का सवाल है, कुल 2792 हितधारकों ने आईएसबीएन पोर्टल पर पंजीकरण कराया, 5,669 आवेदन प्राप्त हुए, और हितधारकों/प्रकाशकों को 84,268 आईएसबीएन आवंटित किए गए।

इस अवधि के दौरान, इनफिलबनेट केंद्र ने 04 संस्थानों के लिए अपनी ILMS सेवा की तैनाती की जिसमें एलायंस यूनिवर्सिटी, बेंगलुरु, कर्नाटक; क्वांटम यूनिवर्सिटी, रुड़की, उत्तराखंड; पतंजलि विश्वविद्यालय, हरिद्वार, उत्तराखंड और सांकलचंद पटेल विश्वविद्यालय, विसनगर, गुजरात शामिल है। रिपोर्ट की

I'm glad to present before you the second quarter issue of the INFLIBNET Newsletter I'm glad to present before you the second quarter issue of the INFLIBNET Newsletter of the year 2023. During the period, the INFLIBNET Centre successfully executed the 8th exercise of India Rankings 2023 under NIRF, which was released by Hon'ble Minister of State for Education and External Affairs, Dr Rajkumar Ranjan Singh on 5th June 2023 at New Delhi. Shri K Sanjay Murthy, Secretary (Higher Education); Prof M Jagadesh Kumar, Chairman, UGC; Prof Anil Sahasrabuddhe, Chairman, NBA and Dr Anil Kumar Nassa, Member Secretary, NBA were also present on the occasion. The work done by the INFLIBNET Centre was highly appreciated there.

Shodh-Chakra, the unique initiative of the Centre to help and support the academic community during the research life cycle, is receiving an overwhelming response from universities across the country, and till the reported period, a total of 95 universities in the country have signed MoUs with the INFLIBNET Centre to use Shodh-Chakra including 13 universities during the period under report.

During the reported period, as far as the allotment of ISBNs through the ISBN portal is concerned, a total of 2792 stakeholders registered on the ISBN portal, 5,669 applications were received, and 84,268 ISBNs were allotted to the stakeholders/ Publishers.

During this period, the INFLIBNET Centre deployed its ILMS service for 04 institutions in the country that are Alliance University, Bengaluru, Karnataka; Quantum University, Roorkee,

गई अवधि तक केंद्र ने संस्थानों के लिए कुल 879 IRINS उदाहरण बनाए हैं, जिसमें रिपोर्ट अवधि के दौरान बनाए गए 97 IRINS उदाहरण भी शामिल हैं। 30 जून 2023 तक, 833 उच्च शिक्षा संस्थानों (734 विश्वविद्यालयों + 99 सीएफटी/आईएनआई) ने इनपिलबनेट केंद्र के साथ शोधगंगा पर समझौता ज्ञापन पर हस्ताक्षर किए हैं, जहां रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि के दौरान 16 समझौता ज्ञापन (13 विश्वविद्यालयों + 03 सीएफटीआई /आईएनआई) जोड़े गए थे। और, शोधगंगा भंडार में जमा किए गए शोध प्रबंधों की कुल संख्या रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि के अंत तक बढ़कर 4,68,492 हो गई है, जिसमें रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि के दौरान अपलोड किए गए 20,363 शोध-प्रबंध शामिल हैं। इसमें कुल 721 विश्वविद्यालय योगदान दे रहे हैं।

इनपिलबनेट केंद्र देश भर के विभिन्न संस्थानों के प्रतिभागियों के बीच प्रशिक्षण प्रदान करने के लिए नियमित रूप से ऑफलाइन/ऑनलाइन विशिष्ट प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम और कार्यशालाएं आयोजित करता है। रिपोर्ट की गई तिमाही के दौरान, केंद्र ने 02 तीन-दिवसीय राष्ट्रीय कार्यशालाएं आयोजित की (एक अनुसंधान पद्धति और नैतिकता पर: साहित्यिक चोरी के मुद्दे, संदर्भ प्रबंधन उपकरण और अल्टमेट्रिक्स, और दूसरी जामोवी का उपयोग करके सांख्यिकीय और खोजपूर्ण डेटा विश्लेषण पर), 02 (1 ऑनलाइन + 1 ऑफलाइन) "SOUL 3.0: स्थापना और संचालन" पर प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम, 02 पांच दिवसीय प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम (एक 'आर' प्रोग्रामिंग का उपयोग करके अनुसंधान डेटा और सांख्यिकीय विश्लेषण पर, और दूसरा ओपन-सोर्स सॉफ्टवेयर का उपयोग करके डिजिटल लाइब्रेरी के निर्माण और प्रबंधन पर)। इसके अलावा, केंद्र ने विभिन्न भारतीय विश्वविद्यालयों के लिए शोध-चक्र पर कुल 05 संस्थागत ऑनलाइन प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम आयोजित किए।

इनपिलबनेट केंद्र ने 21 जून 2023 को अपने परिसर में "9वां अंतर्राष्ट्रीय योग दिवस: वसुधैव कुटुंबकम् के लिए योग" मनाया।

Uttarakhand; University of Patanjali, Haridwar, Uttarakhand and Sankalchand Patel University, Visnagar, Gujarat. The Centre has created a total number of 879 IRINS instances for institutions till the reported period including 97 IRINS instances created during the reported period. As of 30th June 2023, 833 Higher Education Institutions (734 Universities + 99 CFTIs/INIs) have signed MoU on Shodhganga with the INFLIBNET Centre where 16 MoUs (13 Universities + 03 CFTIs/INIs) were added during the reported period. And the total number of theses deposited into the Shodhganga repository has grown up to 4,68,492 by the end of the reported period including 20,363 Theses that were uploaded during the reported period. A total of 721 Universities are contributing to it.

The INFLIBNET Centre regularly conducts Offline/Online Specialized Training Programmes & Workshops to impart training among participants from different institutions across the country. During the reported quarter, the Centre conducted 02 Three-Days National Workshops (one on Research Methodology and Ethics: Plagiarism Issues, Reference Management Tools and Altmetrics, and another one on Statistical and Exploratory Data Analysis using Jamovi), 02 (1 online + 1 offline) training programmes on "SOUL 3.0: Installation and Operations", 02 Five-days Training Programmes (one on Research Data and Statistical Analysis using 'R' Programming, and another one on Creation and Management of Digital Library using Open-Source Software". Five-days Hands-on Training Programme on Research Data and Statistical Analysis using R Programming was organized by Gujarat Biotechnology Research Centre (GBRC), Gandhinagar in collaboration with the INFLIBNET Centre at GBRC, Gandhinagar from 17th to 21st April 2023. On the first day, the training was inaugurated by Chief Guest, Prof Sher Ali, Distinguished Professor at Era University, Director of GBRC, Prof Chaitanya Joshi and Joint Directors, Dr Madhvi Joshi and Dr Amrutlal Patel.

A pre-evaluation quiz was conducted before getting into the real learning sessions. In the first session, participants were introduced to Data

Current Status of INFLIBNET Projects

Release of India Rankings 2023 under National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF)

The INFLIBNET Centre has executed the 8th exercise of NIRF i.e., India Rankings 2023 of HEIs in India. The Centre has developed several modules of NIRF such as data capturing system, feedback system, and ranking module along with research data incorporation. India Rankings 2023 was released by Hon'ble Minister of State for Education and External Affairs, Dr Rajkumar Ranjan Singh on 5th June 2023 at New Delhi. Shri

K Sanjay Murthy, Secretary (Higher Education); Prof M Jagadesh Kumar, Chairman, UGC; Prof Anil Sahasrabuddhe, Chairman, NBA and Dr Anil Kumar Nassa, Member Secretary, NBA were present on the occasion along with Vice-Chancellors and Directors of institutions of higher education of the country. A total number of 5,543 unique institutions participated for ranking under 13 different ranked categories.



India Rankings 2023, the 8th edition of NIRF was distinct in nature as three additions were made into it: i) a new category namely ‘Agriculture & Allied Sectors’ was introduced; ii) previously executed Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements (ARIIA) by AICTE was integrated to NIRF as “Innovation (NIRF-Innovation 2023)” category to reduce the burden on institutions of providing similar data to two different agencies, and iii) scope of “Architecture” category was expanded to “Architecture and Planning” to include institutions imparting courses in Urban and Town Planning. Thus, the ranking portfolio of India Rankings has now increased to 13 categories that were ranked in India Rankings 2023.

Shodh-Chakra: A Gateway to Researchers for Resources

Shodh-Chakra is an initiative of the INFLIBNET Centre under the guidance of UGC to help the academic community during their research life cycle. Shodh-Chakra provides a unique space for the researcher, guide/supervisor and university to manage the research lifecycle of a research scholar. The portal is integrated with millions of resources (including full-text theses) along with the helping tools for the researcher which are required during the research work. A total of 95 Universities have already signed MoU with the INFLIBNET Centre to use Shodh-Chakra including 13 Universities those have signed MoU during the reported period. International Standard Book Number (ISBN)

As approved by the Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, the INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar has been given the task to manage and execute its day-to-day activities, including registration, applications and allotment of ISBN as well as technical maintenance of the ISBN Portal. The Centre has already migrated from the old to the new ISBN portal and is currently in the process of revamping the ISBN website.

During the reported period (01st April 2023 to 30th June 2023), a total of 2792 stakeholders registered on the ISBN portal where 5,669 applications were received, and 84,268 ISBNs were allotted to the stakeholders/Publishers.

INFLIBNET Learning Management Service (ILMS)

INFLIBNET Learning Management Service (ILMS) is a service offered by the Information and Library Network Centre to institutions of higher education across the country. This service is being offered to all the Central, State and Deemed universities. Some of the core features are Course creation, Enrolment, Assignment & Assessment, Discussion forum, etc. A total of 86 institutions participated for ILMS, however, 43 institutes' ILMS status is active till the end of the reporting period. During this reported period, the INFLIBNET Centre deployed its free ILMS service to four institutions that are Alliance University, Bengaluru, Karnataka; Quantum University, Roorkee, Uttarakhand; University of Patanjali, Haridwar, Uttarakhand and Sankalchand Patel University, Visnagar, Gujarat.

Indian Research Information Network System (IRINS)

IRINS is a web-based Research Information Management (RIM) service provided to higher education institutions in India by the INFLIBNET Centre. IRINS facilitates the academic, R&D organizations and faculty members, and scientists to collect, curate and showcase scholarly communication activities and provides an opportunity to create a scholarly network. The INFLIBNET Centre has created a total number of 879 IRINS instances for institutions till the reported period including 97 IRINS instances that were created during the period under report. IRINS has connected a total of 1,41,685 faculty members through this project. The project retrieved a total of 20,28,447 publications metadata from various sources and received a total of 2,01,06,225 citations & received a total of 78,59,196 Altmetrics mentions till the reported period.

National Portal for Transgender Persons (TG Portal)

Under an MoU with the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Department of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India, the INFLIBNET Centre has developed the 'National Portal for Transgender Persons'. The portal enables a transgender person to apply for a certificate and identity card digitally from anywhere in the country, without having to visit any office. The Centre has continued the services as per the MoU.

The below table shows the statistics about the number of applications received, certificates & ID cards issued, etc. during the reported period.

Shodhganga

The Year 2023 is marked as a remarkable period for Shodhganga for its growth by carve-in PhD Theses from most renewed National Institutions Like IITs/IIMs/NITs etc. Shodhganga, a repository of full-text theses in Indian Universities has grown progressively during the period under report. Till 30th June 2023, a total of 833 (734 Universities + 99 CFTIs/INIs) have signed MoU on Shodhganga with the INFLIBNET Centre resulting in an increase in the number of full-text theses in Shodhganga where 16 MoUs (13 Univ + 03 CFTs/INIs) were added during the period. As such, the repository has grown progressively during the period under the report. The total number of theses deposited in the repository has grown up to 4,68,492 by the contribution of 721 contributing Universities. The total theses uploaded (Fig-1) in the Quarter-Q2 (April-June 2023) are 20,363.

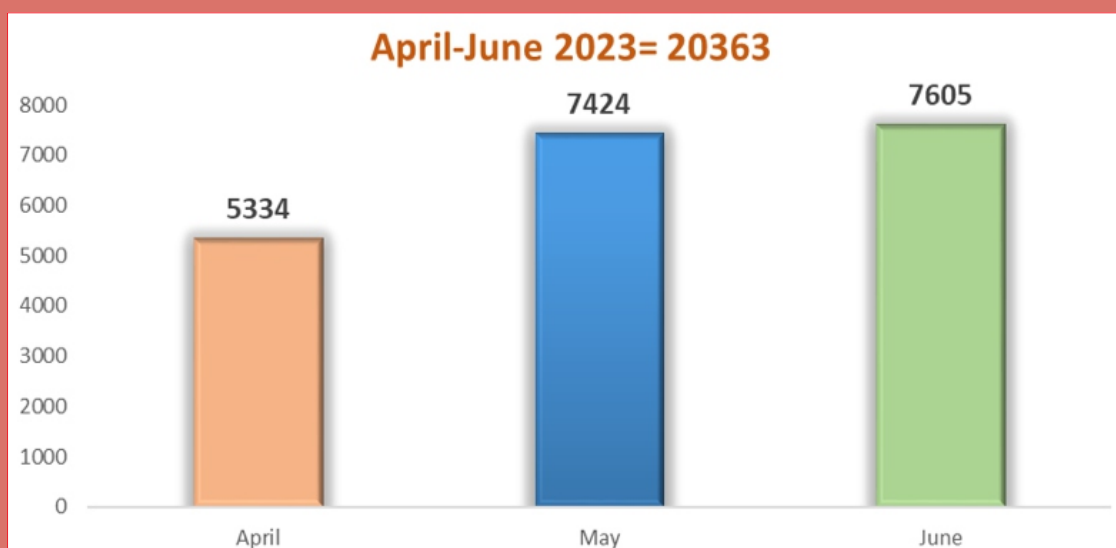


Figure 1: Theses uploaded to Shodhganga

New Feature Added

Social Media Plugin added to Shodhganga Theses

ShareAlike (SA) is a licencing feature given in creative common licence of Shodhganga under CC-BY-NC-SA . ShareAlike enables to share and disseminate the content through social media platform. Social Media Plugins feature for sharing is now incorporated in Shodhganga. The plugins enable the users to share the Thesis on their social media profiles with a single click across 40+ most popular social channels including Facebook, Twitter, WhatsApp and LinkedIn etc.

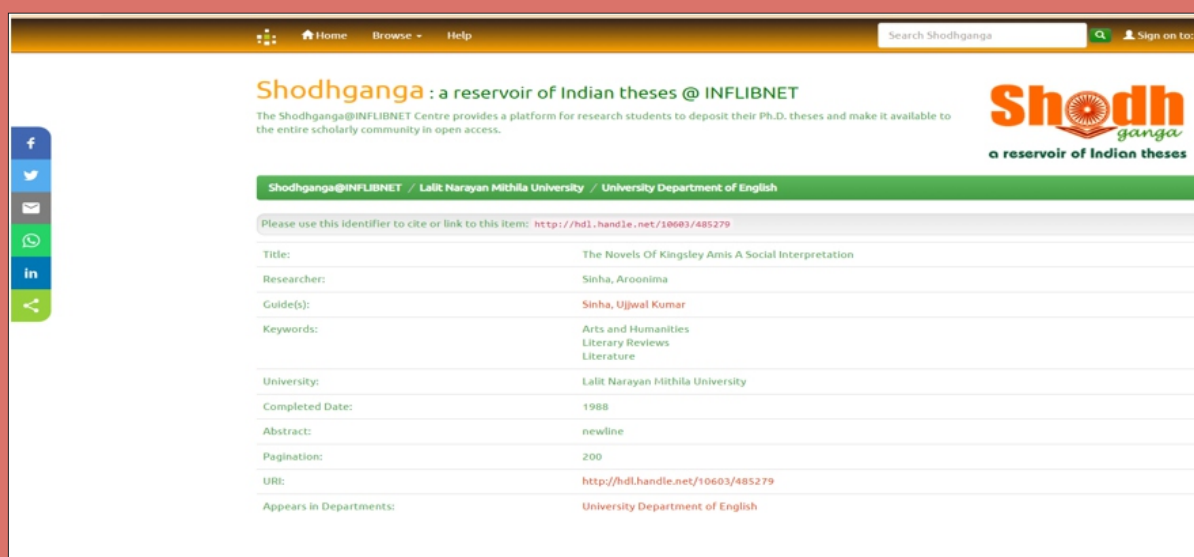


Figure 2: Social Media Plugins added to Shodhganga

Shodhgangotri

Shodhgangotri is open to PG dissertations based on request of Ministry of Ayush. total of 12112 Synopses/MRPs/PDFs/Fellowships have been submitted to the repository by contribution of 116 Universities. 1586 Synopses/ MRPs/ PDFs/Fellowship were added during this period.

A separate category of "PG Dissertation" for "Ministry of Ayush" is created and test uploaded PG Dissertation into the Shodhgangotri. The Ministry of Ayush has appreciated this initiative for creating the separate instance in a prompt manner.

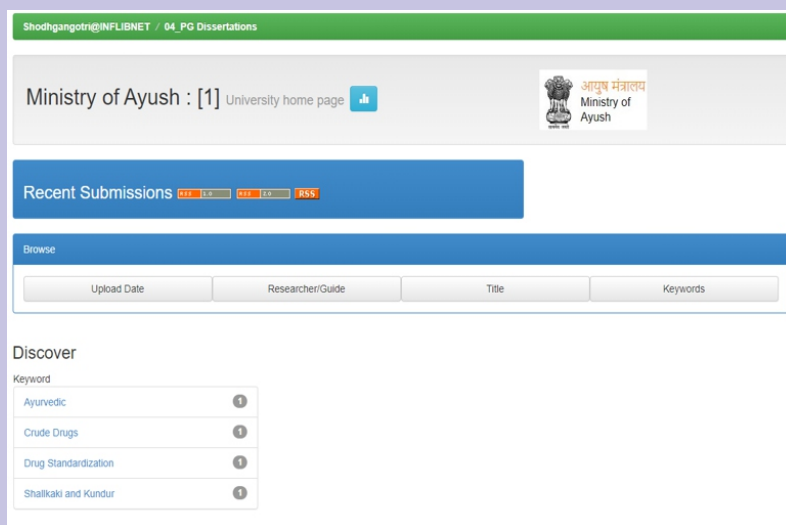


Figure 3: Instance of the Ministry of Ayush in Shodhgangotri

ShodhShuddhi and Plagiarism Detection Software (PDS)

The Ministry of Education through its initiative ShodhShuddhi provides access to Plagiarism Detection Software (PDS) to all Universities including Central, State, Deemed, and Private Universities, as well as Centrally funded Technical Institutions/Institutes of National Importance (CFTIs/INIs) in India through Central funding to enhance academic integrity in academic institutions and to curb plagiarism, w.e.f. 01st September 2019. As on 30th June 2023, a total of 32,76,240 documents have been submitted for checking similarity/plagiarism by 1,46,880 users from 911 Universities/Institutions. The Project Shodhshuddhi envisaged use of 30 Lakhs documents in 3 years with 10 Lakhs document in each year and 32.76 Lakhs documents are already submitted till end of 30th June 2023. Current period of subscription ended on 31st May 2023 which is further extended for 4 Months till September 2023 and Global Tender Enquiry (GTE) is already being floated.

Usage Statistics of PDS during the period under report

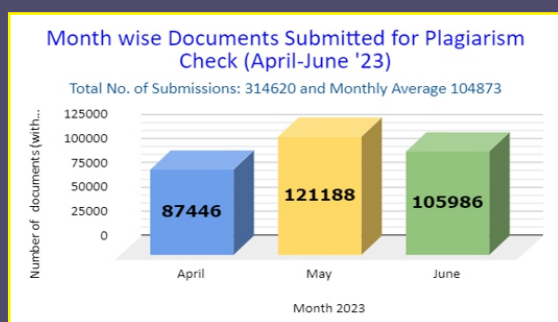


Figure 4: No. of Submissions in PDS month-wise (April-June 2023)

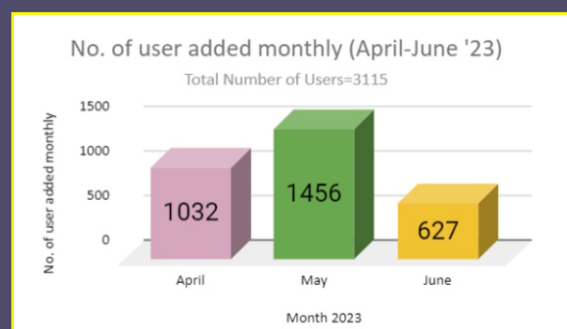


Figure 5: No. of New Users added during the period

Total Submission of documents into PDS during the period under report 3,14,620. Figure 4 shows the average number of submissions in the last 3 months (April-June 2023 = 3,14,620), and the average was 1,04,873. Total number of 3115 new users were added to ShodhShuddhi during April-June 2023 and Figure 5 shows the month-wise addition of users. In the month of May 2023 the highest number of Submissions were made by HEIs (i.e. 1,21,188) since inception of the project.

The graph (Figure-5) shows the total number of users created/added in ShodhShuddhi to date is 1,46,880 users whereas the number of users added monthly (April-May-June 2023 = 3,115) are as follows (April = 1,032, May = 1,456, and June = 627). PDS has a provision for 3 Lakhs users from all Universities.

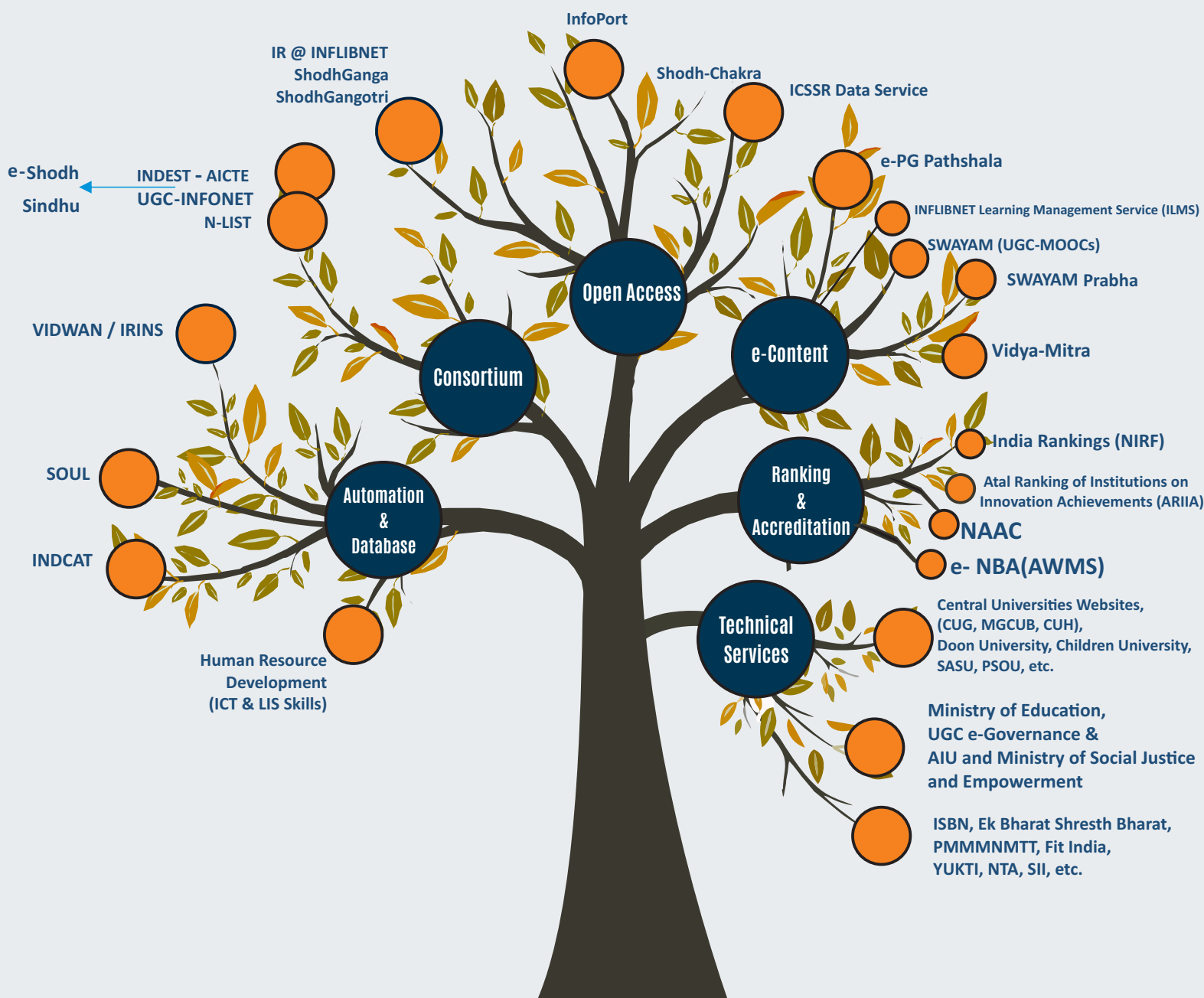
