Page 3, Clause # 2.4 - EMD:	Request you to kindly include exemption under NSIC also.	<p>Micro and small Enterprises if registered with any government bodies specified by Ministry of Micro, Small &amp; Medium Enterprises (M/o MSME) with valid certificate duly issued by GOI are exempted for submitting the earnest money deposit (EMD). It will be applicable for those bidders who shall produce their own goods or provide their own services, and not applicable for trading purpose. No entrepreneur or memorandum of application form is acceptable.</p> <p>Other Firms, registered with MSME / NSIC with valid certificate duly issued by GOI are also exempted for submitting EMD. No other type of certificate is acceptable.</p> <p>The exemption and relaxation in EMD is subject to the validity &amp; acceptance of their registration certificate on the date of opening of tender.</p> <p><b>Document Required for Availing Exemption of EMD Amount for NSIC/ MSEs_</b></p> <p>A. MSMEs, which are specified by the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises under MSMED Act 2006 and Public Procurement Policy, 2012 as Manufacturing/Service Enterprises should have registered with NSIC under its Single Point Registration Scheme (SPRS).</p> <p>B. The certificate with monetary limit indicated should be valid on the scheduled date/Extended date of submission of tender. Certificates without monetary limit will not be considered.</p> <p>C. The items of Product/Services mentioned under NSIC certificate should be the same or similar to the tendered items (Schedule of items of Tendered).</p> <p>D. The monetary limit stipulated in the certificate of MSMEs/NSIC should be equal or more than the value of work in hand awarded under MSME</p>
